OBJECTIVES:

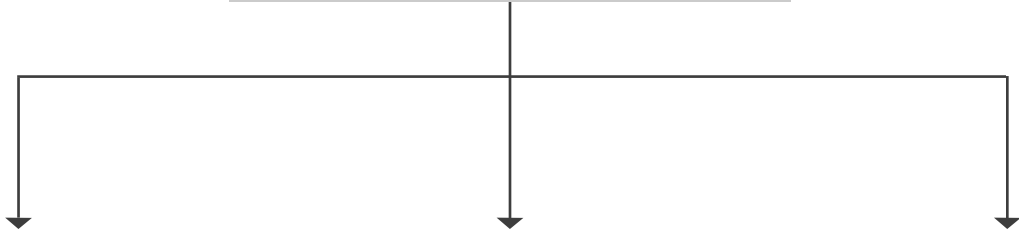
What values and virtues do you feel would best benefit the modern knight or lady?
